dining car gathered around her, including the waiter, and no one ordered a drink. One man said to her, "Where did you get this?" She replied, "At the foot of the cross." "How did you get to the foot of the cross?" the man asked. "At the end of my rope," replied Mary. For two and one half hours, the whole dining car listened to this young woman describe the "how" of Christianity.

HOW? That is what people really want to know. How? They are more or less convinced that it (Christianity) is true, but how do you get it?

Mary Webster knew how to answer the "how" question. Jones met Mary Webster in the 1950s and found her to be a profound example of how an ordinary life transformed and redeemed could become a force for sharing the love of Jesus Christ to all she encountered.

Mary felt that she was not the source of things but only the channel and that God spoke to her directly. And He does! She says: "A watch doesn't create time -it simply registers it. A violin doesn't create music -it simply registers the music in the violinist. So we don't create -we transmit." She is the clearest channel of transmission I've ever seen. ## **Passion for People**



#### Jones' Transformation

Jones describes his experience of complete transformation. He had left the mission field to recuperate for a year in the United States as his health had "broken." Upon his return to India, he had to go to the mountains to again, try to restore his health. He tells this story

"Back from furlough of a year, the first thing I had to think about was my own health. I came down from the mountains and had to go back again. When I came down the second time, I knew the game was up—I would have to leave the mission field and my work and try to regain my shattered health. In that dark hour I was in the Central Methodist Church in Lucknow. I was at the back of the church kneeling in prayer, not for myself but for others, when God said to me: "Are you yourself ready for the work to which I have called you?" My reply: "No, Lord, I'm done for. I've reached the end of my resources and I can't go on." God responded, "If you'll turn that problem over to me and not worry about it, I'll take care of it." My eager reply: "Lord, I close the bargain right here."



I arose from my knees knowing I was a well man. As I walked home, my feet scarcely touched the earth, I was possessed with life and health and peace. I was flooded with a sense of energy, of peace, of power, of adequacy. And, I knew that is was no wave of passing emotion that would recede and leave me with nothing but my own resources. Rather, I was in possession of the Holy Spirit and the Spirit of Trust who should abide forever.

Without that total rescuing from weakness to strength, from confusion to certainty, from inner conflict to unity, from myself to his Self, I doubt whether I would have had the nerve to undertake this work to which I had been called. It was too demanding, too baffling, and too overwhelmingly difficult to match it with bare human resources.

But now I saw my resources. As I look back, I now see that it was good that I should start with so little, for I could take so much. From nothing I was led into His everything.
